CALIBRACHOA

Planting

PH	Recommended pH levels are between 5.5 and 5.8.
Media	Porous, well-drained media.
Uses	Pots, baskets and combinations.
Plants/Pot	4" - 1ppp - 8 weeks to finish 6" - 2ppp - 8 weeks to finish 10" - 3ppp - 10 weeks to finish

Climate

Lighting	4000 to 6000 ft candles
Light Notes	High light levels promote compact and well-branched growth.
Hardiness	Day: 68-72 ° F. Night: 64-68 ° F Zones: 10-11

Growing

Micronutrients	Necessary. Foliar iron spray necessary if pH is too high.
Notes	200 to 250 ppm N. Maintain media pH below 6.0. Media EC 1.2-1.5.
Water Requirements	Allow plants to dry between watering. Irrigate media so it is wet to the touch, but not saturated.
Growth Regulators	B-9 and Sumagic.
Pinching	Recommended to improve branching and compactness. Pinch back to 3 nodes.

Pest Control

Insects	Aphids , Thrip
Disease	Pythium, Botrytis
